

TIGRAY CRISIS



Atrocities and crimes

- > 2.3 million Tigrayans internally displaced
- >70,000 Tigrayans refugees in Sudan
- > 250 massacre sites identified
- >22,000 women raped in just the first four months

Famine

- >6 million Tigrayans (91% of the population) in need of urgent food aid
- >1,000,000 Tigrayans are in famine condition
- >100,000 children are at risk of death



Agricultural destruction

- > 90% of the harvest looted or destroyed
- > 80% of the livestock looted or killed

Collapse of the health system

- >70% health facilities looted or destroyed, 40 hospitals, 234 HC,
- >10,000 children died of severe malnutrition as of January....2022
- >48,000 HIV patients with no ARVs
- >10,000 TB patients (estimate), >2400 MDR
- >10,000 Cardiovascular diseases
- >10,000 diabetic patients with no insulin
- >1,000 cancer patients with no chemotherapy
- > 500 with kidney failures with no dialysis services
- >500,000 at risk of COVID-19 infection
- Zero COVID-19 tests available and Zero COVID-19 treatments and oxygen support
- Zero Protective gloves, IV fluid, catheters, sterile syringes & needles
- Zero Disinfectants, soap, antibiotics, antianelgestics, vitamins, etc
- Zero cash to pay salaries of >20,000 health staff,
